



**MONMOUTH COUNTY REGIONAL HEALTH COMMISSION NO. 1
ORDINANCE NO. 17-06**

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING AN ORDINANCE ENTITLED “AN ORDINANCE
ESTABLISHING AND FIXING FEES FOR NON-FOOD INSPECTION SERVICES”**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MONMOUTH COUNTY REGIONAL HEALTH COMMISSION NO.1 (hereinafter, “Commission”) CREATED AND OPERATING UNDER N.J.S.A. 26:3-83 ET SEQ., AND THE SEVERAL ACTS AMENDATORY THEREOF AND SUPPLEMENTARY THERETO AND COMPRISED OF THE BOARDS OF HEALTH OF THE BOROUGHES OF ALLENHURST, BRIELLE, DEAL, FAIR HAVEN, HIGHLANDS, INTERLAKEN, LITTLE SILVER, LOCH ARBOUR, LONG BRANCH, MONMOUTH BEACH, RED BANK, RUMSON, SEA BRIGHT, SEA GIRT, SHREWSBURY, SPRING LAKE, SPRING LAKE HEIGHTS, TINTON FALLS AND WEST LONG BRANCH AND THE TOWNSHIPS OF MIDDLETOWN, OCEAN AND WALL, EACH AND ALL IN THE COUNTY OF MONMOUTH AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY, THAT THE FOLLOWING ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING AND FIXING FEES FOR HEALTH SERVICES AND ACTIVITIES PROVIDED BY THE MONMOUTH COUNTY REGIONAL HEALTH COMMISSION NO. 1 AND REQUIRED BY THE CONSTRUCTION OF NEW, REPAIRED AND/OR ALTERED SUBSURFACE SEWERAGE DISPOSAL SYSTEMS, NEW PUBLIC SWIMMING POOLS, WHIRLPOOLS AND SPAS AND, NEW PRIVATE DOMESTIC WELLS AND IRRIGATION WELLS, ESTABLISHMENTS REGULATED BY NJ BODY ART CODE CHAPTER 8 N.J.A.C. 8:27-1 et seq., KENNELS/PET SHOPS/POUNDS AND SHELTERS, AND TOBACCO RETAIL ESTABLISHMENTS/CIGAR BARS/LOUNGES, DAYCARE, PRESCHOOL OR SCHOOLS AND ALL REQUESTS FOR NON-OPEN OFFICIAL RECORD SEARCHES BE FIXED HEREIN SET FORTH:

Section 1. The Commission hereby establishes and fixes the following fees for non-food health services:

1.1 **Sewerage Disposal System**

Fees for each new, altered or repaired individual subsurface sewerage disposal system are hereby fixed as follows:

Witnessing of soil logs, perks, etc. Minimum two (2) holes	\$160.00 base charge
Additional charge for each hole above the base charge shall be fixed at	\$40.00 per hole

Plan Review fees: New system, alteration, or repair requiring a licensed P.E.	\$295.00
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Inspection fees: Inspection Fee for new system, alteration, or repair requiring a licensed Professional Engineer	\$370.00
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Repairs made to an existing septic system which does not require a licensed Professional Engineer	\$195.00
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Witnessing of septic system abandonment (not in conjunction with a new or altered system):	\$160.00
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1.2 **Body Art**

Fees for plan review and annual health license permit for establishments regulated by the N.J. Body Art Code - Chapter 8 N.J.A.C. 8:27-1 et seq.

- a) Annual health licensing permit fee \$160.00
- b) Plan review fee for a new establishment \$300.00

1.3 **Public Swimming Pools/Private Recreational Bathing Facilities (Not Residential)**

Fees for plan review of new public swimming pools, whirlpools and spas and annual license permits are herein fixed as follows:

Plan review each public swimming pool	\$370.00
Plan review each public whirlpool	\$185.00
Plan review each public spa	\$185.00
Plan review for public spray park/splash park/float tank	\$185.00
Annual health license permit for a swimming pool	\$125.00
Annual health license permit for a whirlpool	\$50.00
Annual health license permit for a spa	\$50.00
Annual health license permit for a spray park/splash/float tank	\$50.00
Annual health license permit for a bathing beach	\$50.00/lifeguard stand

1.4 **Kennels, Pet Shops, Pounds or Shelters**

Fees for plan review of new kennels, pet shops, pounds or shelters,

Plan review each kennel, pet shop, pound or shelter	\$200.00
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1.5 **Private Wells and Private Irrigation Wells**

Fees for inspection and activities associated with private wells and private irrigation wells are fixed as follows:

Private well plan review (category 1-potable water supply wells or category 2-non-potable water supply wells)	\$75.00
Private well construction inspection and certification of laboratory water analysis report	\$285.00
Private irrigation well construction inspection	\$125.00
Realty transfer review and certification of Laboratory water analysis report	\$35.00

1.6 **Daycare Center, Preschool or School**

Fees for re-audit of a daycare center, preschool or school due to immunization noncompliance	\$50.00
Second re-audit	\$160.00
Third re-audit	\$160.00

1.7 **New Jersey Smoke-Free Air Act**

Fees for activities associated with the New Jersey Smoke-Free Air Act, Chapter 383, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 26:3D-55 et seq. and N.J.A.C. 8:6 are herein fixed as follows:

Review and processing of Notice of Claim of Exemption of Tobacco Retail Establishment \$235.00

Application for an annual review and processing of Renewal of Notice of Claim of Exemption of Tobacco Retail Establishment \$75.00

Review and processing of Application for Registration of Exempt Cigar Bar or Cigar Lounge \$310.00

Review and processing of Application for Renewal of Registration of Exempt Cigar Bar or Cigar Lounge \$75.00

1.8 The Commission hereby establishes and fixes the following fees for vaccine administration fees:

1.8 a. **Vaccine Administration (applicable to Government funded vaccine VFC and VFA)**

- Vaccine for Children Administration Fee for uninsured patrons (VFC) \$12.00
- Vaccine for Adults Administration Fee for uninsured and underinsured patrons (VFA) \$24.00

Administrative fees may be waived for low income individuals or special programs offered by the Commission.

Section 2. All fees covered pursuant to Section 1.1 et. seq. of this, Ordinance, with the exception of Section 1.2 a) Annual Health Licensing Permit Fee, shall be paid directly to the Commission within that health agency’s geographic jurisdiction which such fees are assessed and collected. The fee covered pursuant to Section 1.2 a) Annual Health Licensing Permit Fee shall be paid directly to the town of geographic jurisdiction wherein the establishment regulated by the Body Art Code is located.

Section 3. The fees assessed pursuant to this Ordinance may not be transferable and upon the sale or transfer of ownership of any such facility or activity contained in Section 1.1 et. seq.; the new owner may be required to make proper application to the Commission or in the case of Section 1.2 a) Annual Health Licensing Permit Fee, to the town of geographic jurisdiction and pay the appropriate fee provided for in section 1.1 et. seq. of this Ordinance.

Section 4. All prior Resolutions or parts of same consistent and/or inconsistent with any of this

Ordinance established hereunder are hereby repealed.

Section 5. In the event that a court of competent jurisdiction shall declare any section, sentence or clause of this Ordinance unconstitutional, such declaration shall not in any manner prejudice the enforcement of the remaining provisions.

Section 6. This Ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days after the first publication thereof after final passage as provided by law.
